All the persons and numbers of present tense of the word *te kerel* [te kərəl]

	sg	pl
1.ps	<i>me kerav</i>	<i>amen keras</i>
2.ps	<i>ty keres</i>	<i>tumen keren</i>
3.ps	<i>jov kerel</i>	<i>jon keren</i>

Various tenses of the same word, all in 2nd person singular.

- present - *tu keres*
- future - *tu ka keres*
- past imperfect = present conditional - *tu kerehas*
- past perfect - *tu kerd'al* (*ker + d + 'al*)
- past conditional - *tu kerd'ala*s (*ker + d + 'al + as*)
- present imperative - *ker!*

## **Class II** [edit]

All the persons and numbers of present tense of the word to

	sg	pl
1.ps	<i>me pat'av</i>	<i>amen pat'as</i>
2.ps	<i>tu pat'as</i>	<i>tumen pat'an</i>
3.ps	<i>joy pat'al</i>	<i>jon pat'an</i>

Various tenses of the word *te chal*, all in 2nd person singular. ☺

- present - *tu dzas*
- future - *tu dzaha*
- past imperfect = present conditional - *tu dzahas*
- past perfect - *tu dzafom* (irregular - regular form of *tu pat'as* is *tu pat'aňom*)
- past conditional - *tu dzafahas*
- present imperative - *dzaňa!*

### Class III [edit]

All the persons and numbers of present tense of the word *te pašfol*.<sup>28</sup> Note the added *-uv-*, which is typical for this group.

	sg	pl
1.ps	<i>me pašluvav</i>	<i>amen pašluvas</i>
2.ps	<i>tu pašlos</i>	<i>tumen pašlon</i>
3.ps	<i>jov pašlol</i>	<i>jon pašlon</i>

Various tenses of the same word, all in 2nd person singular again.

- present - *tu paščos*
- future - *tu pašča*
- past imperfect = present conditional - *tu paščas*
- past perfect - *tu paščilal* (*pašč* + *il* + *'al*)
- past conditional - *tu paščilalas* (*pašč* + *il* + *'al* + *as*)
- present imperative - *paščuv!*
